RESOLUTION

Instructing the managers on the part of the Senate on the bill S. 1790 (116th Congress) to require certain measures to address Federal election interference by foreign governments.

- 1 *Resolved,* ^{that} The managers on the part of the Senate at
2 the conference on the disagreeing votes of the two Houses
3 on the House amendment to the bill S. 1790 (116th Con-
4 gress) are instructed to require the appropriate official of
5 the executive branch, after each Federal election, to
6 promptly submit to Congress a determination as to wheth-
7 er the Government of the Russian Federation, or any
8 other foreign government, has interfered in such election

1 and a detailed assessment of any such interference that
2 identifies, to the maximum extent practicable, the individ-
3 uals responsible for the interference, and to promptly im-
4 pose sanctions on any foreign government that has been
5 determined to have interfered in a Federal election, includ-
6 ing specified individuals and entities within the territory
7 of that government.
